HE'S SAVED...But is He For Real?

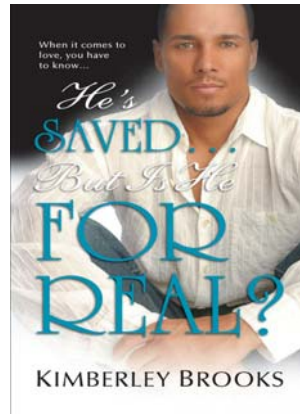
